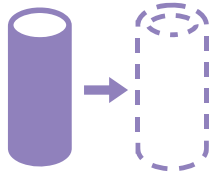


2021 In Review

We are making changes that will deliver the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) line to northwest Toronto. In 2021, crews created space for the LRT line by moving, replacing, and constructing key infrastructure along the route, while building connections throughout the community!

BUILDING UP



Installed over 26 km of storm, sanitary, and sewer pipes, plus 818 manholes, track drains and catch basins



Planted 385 trees and 4,600 plants



Over 28,000 m³ of concrete poured, equal to 11 olympic size swimming pools

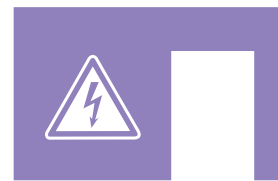
MAKING PROGRESS



By end of 2021, crews installed almost 5 km of rail line

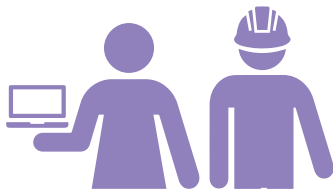


229 of 477 Overhead Catenary System (OCS) poles have been installed
